General Information

The competitions are organized based on the International Competition Rules (ICR) as published on the FIS Homepage. All competitors participating in FIS events must carry accident insurance in sufficient amounts to cover accident, transport and rescue costs including race risks, as well as an appropriate third party liability insurance. The National Associations are responsible for adequate insurance coverage of all their competitors sent and inscribed by them. The NSA or their competitors must be able to show proof of the respective insurance coverage at any time on request of FIS representatives or the OC (ICR 212.4)

Entries:

NSAs/Teams need to maintain entries through the FIS Online Entry System in the member section of the FIS Homepage. Deadlines for Preliminary Entries and Entries are shown in the FIS entry system.

Economical obligations & Reimbursement

- Payment of expenses will be in accordance with the 'RULES FOR THE FIS CUP SKI JUMPING (MEN)' and the 'THE INTERNATIONAL SKI COMPETITION RULES (ICR)'
- Expenses will be paid through bank transfers.
